

## **Main findings**

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages. This approach is supported by ABS advice on analysis of regional labour force estimates (see Table 16(b) of *Labour Force, Australia, Detailed* (cat. no. 6291.0.55.001)).

- The number of employed persons in Moreton Bay South SA4 in January 2020 was 114,700 persons, an increase of 2,300 employed persons, or 2.0% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, January 2020

- The unemployment rate in Moreton Bay South SA4 in January 2020 was 5.5 per cent, an increase of 0.2 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Moreton Bay South SA4 in January 2020 was 71.7 per cent, a decrease of 0.7 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
