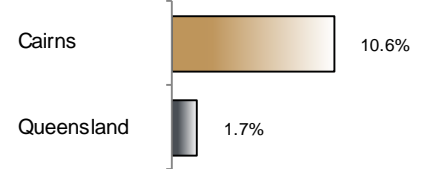

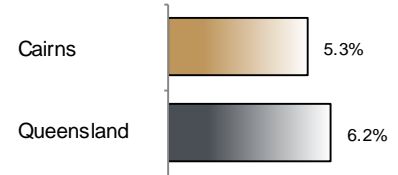

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data. This volatility means it can be difficult to detect real world phenomena, such as those caused by the social distancing measures introduced to combat COVID-19, in the data. **As a result, it is not recommended regional labour force data be used to assess the impact of COVID-19.**

- The number of employed persons in Cairns SA4 in April 2020 was 133,800 persons, an increase of 12,800 employed persons, or 10.6% over the year (Figure 1).

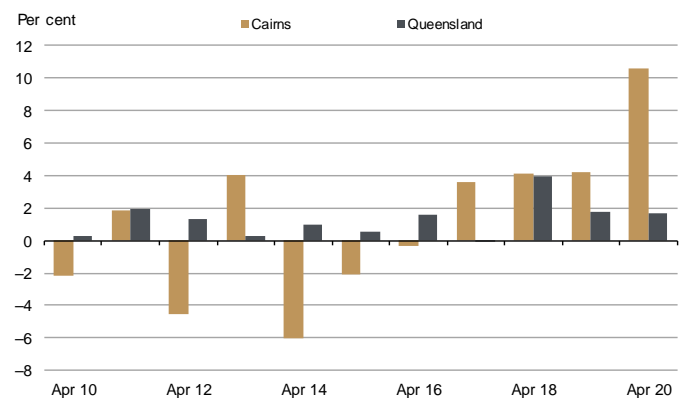


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, April 2020

- The unemployment rate in Cairns SA4 in April 2020 was 5.3 per cent, an increase of 0.5 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Cairns SA4 in April 2020 was 69.2 per cent, an increase of 6.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Cairns SA4
