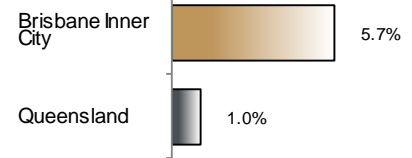

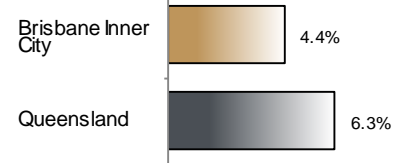

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data. This volatility means it can be difficult to detect real world phenomena, such as those caused by the social distancing measures introduced to combat COVID-19, in the data. **As a result, it is not recommended regional labour force data be used to assess the impact of COVID-19.**

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in May 2020 was 184,600 persons, an increase of 9,900 employed persons, or 5.7% over the year (Figure 1).

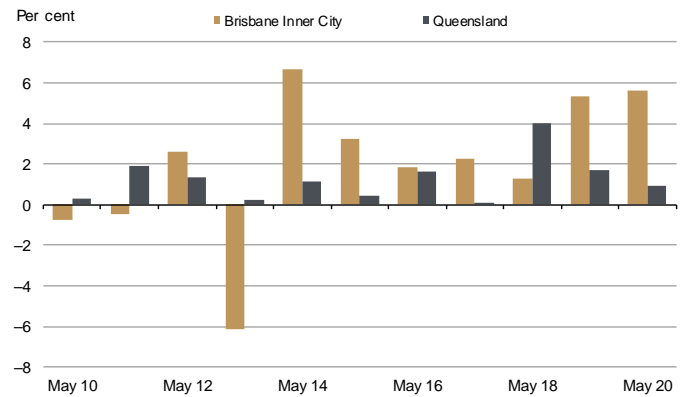


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2020

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in May 2020 was 4.4 per cent, unchanged over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in May 2020 was 76.0 per cent, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane Inner City SA4
