



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data. This volatility means it can be difficult to detect real world phenomena, such as those caused by the social distancing measures introduced to combat COVID-19, in the data. As a result, it is not recommended regional labour force data be used to assess the impact of COVID-19. All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Sunshine Coast SA4 in March 2021 was 179,100 persons, a decrease of 10,000 employed persons, or 5.3% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2021

- The unemployment rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in March 2021 was 6.9 per cent, an increase of 1.2 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the ninth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in March 2021 was 59.2 per cent, a decrease of 3.9 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Sunshine Coast SA4
