Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- Gold Coast SA4 had the largest annual growth in employment of all 19 SA4s during November 2024 with a growth of 19,200 employed persons (Figure 1).





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, Nov 24

- Darling Downs - Maranoa SA4 had the lowest unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during November 2024 with an unemployment rate of 2.2 per cent (Figure 2).
- Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 had the largest percentage point decrease in unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to November 2024 with an unemployment rate decrease of 1.9 percentage points (Table 1).
- Brisbane Inner City SA4 had the highest participation rate of all 19 SA4s during November 2024 with 78.5 per cent and Wide Bay had the lowest participation rate with 52.3 per cent.

Figure 1 Annual change in employment by SA4, Nov 24
