






#### Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Mackay - Isaac -Whitsunday SA4

## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in December 2024 was 103,700 persons, an increase of 300 employed persons, or 0.3% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in December 2024 was 2.2 per cent, a decrease of 1.8 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in December 2024 was 68.0 per cent, a decrease of 2.5 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
