



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Moreton Bay North SA4 in December 2024 was 132,100 persons, an increase of 14,800 employed persons, or 12.6% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, December 2024

- The unemployment rate in Moreton Bay North SA4 in December 2024 was 4.7 per cent, a decrease of 1.8 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Moreton Bay North SA4 in December 2024 was 57.5 per cent, an increase of 3.9 percentage points over the year (Table 1).



Totals may differ due to rounding. Figures are rounded to nearest 100 persons. Calculations are based on pre-rounded figures.
