

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Sunshine Coast SA4 in December 2024 was 225,800 persons, an increase of 4,700 employed persons, or 2.1% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, December 2024

- The unemployment rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in December 2024 was 3.4 per cent, an increase of 0.2 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in December 2024 was 64.5 per cent, a decrease of 0.3 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Sunshine Coast
