



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Cairns SA4 in January 2025 was 141,800 persons, an increase of 2,400 employed persons, or 1.7% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, January 2025

- The unemployment rate in Cairns SA4 in January 2025 was 3.4 per cent, a decrease of 0.1 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the sixthlowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Cairns SA4 in January 2025 was 66.3 per cent, a decrease of 0.2 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Cairns SA4
