




#### Employment growth, annual

## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Gold Coast SA4 in January 2025 was 381,100 persons, an increase of 18,000 employed persons, or 5.0% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Gold Coast SA4 in January 2025 was 3.4 per cent, unchanged over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Gold Coast SA4 in January 2025 was 67.4 per cent, an increase of 1.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
