

# Regional labour force – Brisbane - South SA4, Feb 25





## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

Townsville and Cairns SA4s have no data due to collection issues following flooding in these regions. Data in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 represents combined estimates for 3 regions: Mackay - Isaac – Whitsunday, Townsville and Cairns SA4s. As such, the comparisons are made across 17 SA4s instead of the usual 19 SA4s.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane South SA4 in February 2025 was 228,400 persons, an increase of 8,600 employed persons, or 3.9% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2025

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane South SA4 in February 2025 was 3.7 per cent, a decrease of 0.1 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the ninth-lowest of all 17 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane South SA4 in February 2025 was 70.4 per cent, an increase of 0.4 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - South
