



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

Townsville and Cairns SA4s have no data due to collection issues following flooding in these regions. Data in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 represents combined estimates for 3 regions: Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday, Townsville and Cairns SA4s. As such, the comparisons are made across 17 SA4s instead of the usual 19 SA4s.

- The number of employed persons in Gold Coast SA4 in February 2025 was 381,000 persons, an increase of 16,600 employed persons, or 4.6% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2025

- The unemployment rate in Gold Coast SA4 in February 2025 was 3.5 per cent, unchanged over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-lowest of all 17 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Gold Coast SA4 in February 2025 was 67.4 per cent, an increase of 1.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Gold Coast SA4
