



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

Townsville and Cairns SA4s have no data due to collection issues following flooding in these regions. Data in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 represents combined estimates for 3 regions: Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday, Townsville and Cairns SA4s. As such, the comparisons are made across 17 SA4s instead of the usual 19 SA4s.

- The number of employed persons in Wide Bay SA4 in February 2025 was 140,700 persons, an increase of 3,600 employed persons, or 2.6% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2025

- The unemployment rate in Wide Bay SA4 in February 2025 was 6.0 per cent, an increase of 0.8 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-highest of all 17 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Wide Bay SA4 in February 2025 was 53.5 per cent, an increase of 0.7 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Wide Bay SA4
