Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

Townsville and Cairns SA4s have no data due to collection issues following flooding in these regions. Data in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 represents combined estimates for 3 regions: Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday, Townsville and Cairns SA4s. As such, the comparisons are made across 17 SA4s instead of the usual 19 SA4s.

- Toowoomba SA4 had the largest annual growth in employment of all 17 SA4s during February 2025 with a growth of 16,700 employed persons (Figure 1).

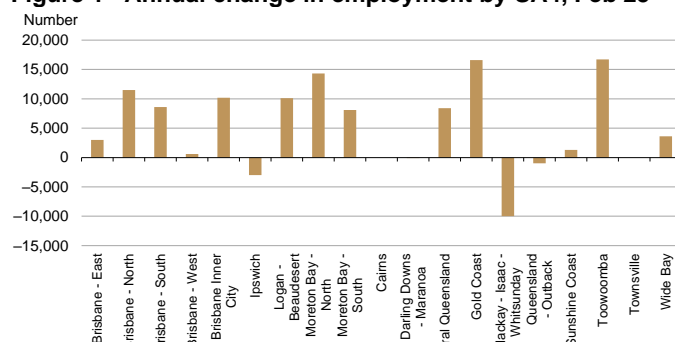
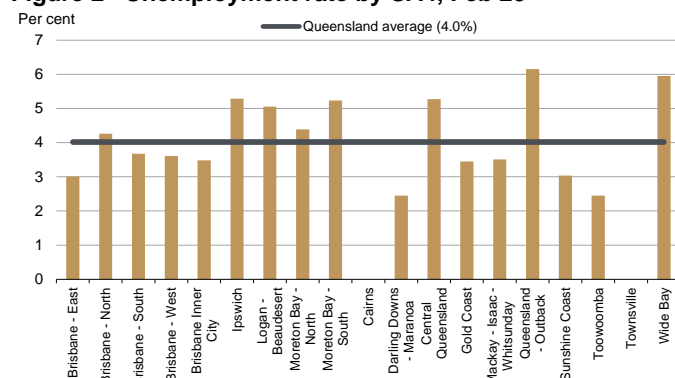


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, Feb 25

- Toowoomba SA4 had the lowest unemployment rate of all 17 SA4s during February 2025 with an unemployment rate of 2.4 per cent (Figure 2).
- Moreton Bay - North SA4 had the largest percentage point decrease in unemployment rate of all 17 SA4s over the year to February 2025 with an unemployment rate decrease of 2.5 percentage points (Table 1).
- Brisbane Inner City SA4 had the highest participation rate of all 17 SA4s during February 2025 with 77.9 per cent and Wide Bay had the lowest participation rate with 53.5 per cent.

Figure 1 Annual change in employment by SA4, Feb 25
