

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

The ABS has imputed sample responses in Moreton Bay - North and Townsville SA4 regions for March 2025 and Townsville SA4 for February 2025 due to recent natural disasters. The ABS recommends caution when using data from these impacted regions for analysis.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in March 2025 was 222,000 persons, an increase of 10,500 employed persons, or 5.0% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, March 2025

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in March 2025 was 3.5 per cent, a decrease of 0.5 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the ninth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in March 2025 was 77.8 per cent, unchanged over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane Inner City SA4
