



Employment growth, annual



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

The ABS has imputed sample responses in Townsville SA4 for February 2025, March 2025 and April 2025 and Moreton Bay - North SA4 for March 2025 due to recent natural disasters. The ABS recommends caution when using data from these impacted regions for analysis.

- The number of employed persons in Townsville SA4 in April 2025 was 121,600 persons, a decrease of 7,900 employed persons, or 6.1% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Townsville SA4 in April 2025 was . 5.3 per cent, an increase of 1.5 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourthhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Townsville SA4 in April 2025 was 65.0 per cent, a decrease of 4.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
