



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data. All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

The ABS has imputed sample responses in Townsville SA4 for February 2025, March 2025 and April 2025 and Moreton Bay - North SA4 for March 2025 due to recent natural disasters. The ABS recommends caution when using data from these impacted regions for analysis.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in May 2025 was 105,100 persons, an increase of 1,100 employed persons, or 1.1% over the year (Figure 1).





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2025

- The unemployment rate in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in May 2025 was 1.8%, a decrease of 2.1 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in May 2025 was 68.4%, a decrease of 1.8 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Mackay - Isaac -Whitsunday SA4
