



Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of regional labour force direct survey estimates.

The ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to address high standard errors and reduce data volatility.

The ABS has imputed sample responses in Townsville SA4 for February 2025, March 2025 and April 2025 and Moreton Bay - North SA4 for March 2025 due to recent natural disasters. The ABS recommends caution when using data from these impacted regions for analysis.

- The number of employed persons in Queensland -Outback SA4 in June 2025 was 40,400 persons, a decrease of 300 employed persons, or 0.7% over the year (Figure 1).





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2025

- The unemployment rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in June 2025 was 5.6%, an increase of 1.0 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the third-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in June 2025 was 67.3%, an increase of 0.3 of a percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Queensland -**Outback SA4**
