Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates.

The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- Gold Coast SA4 had the largest annual growth in employment of all 19 SA4s during July 2025 with a growth of 14,100 employed persons (Figure 1).

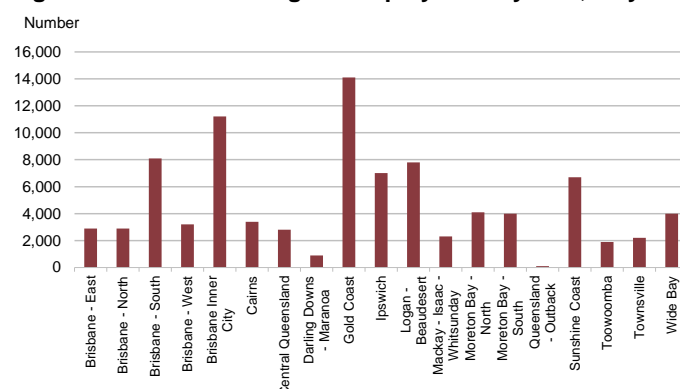
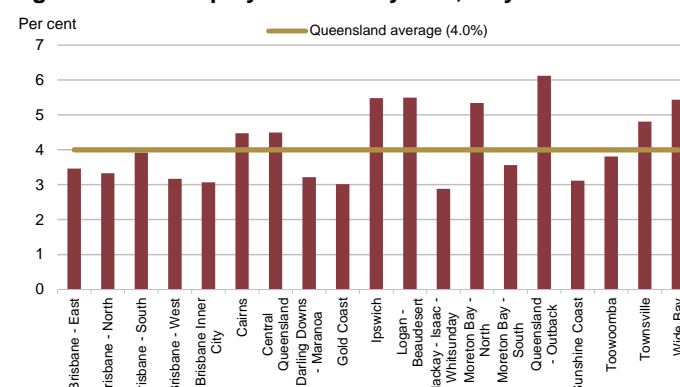


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, July 2025

- Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 had the lowest unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during July 2025 with an unemployment rate of 2.9% (Figure 2).
- Moreton Bay - North SA4 had the largest percentage point decrease in unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to July 2025 with an unemployment rate decrease of 0.3 percentage points (Table 1).
- Brisbane Inner City SA4 had the highest participation rate of all 19 SA4s during July 2025 with 78.3% and Wide Bay had the lowest participation rate with 52.9%.

Figure 1 Annual change in employment by SA4, July 2025
