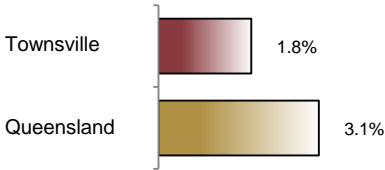

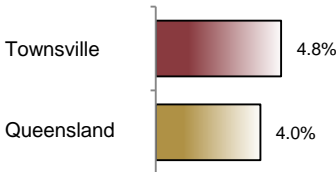

Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates.

The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- The number of employed persons in Townsville SA4 in July 2025 was 126,500 persons, an increase of 2,200 employed persons, or 1.8% over the year (Table 1).

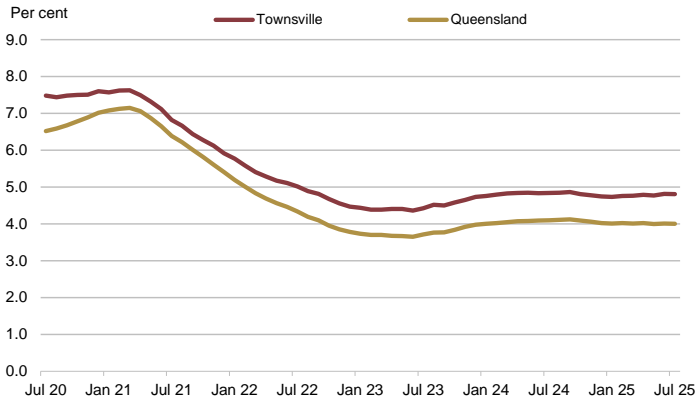
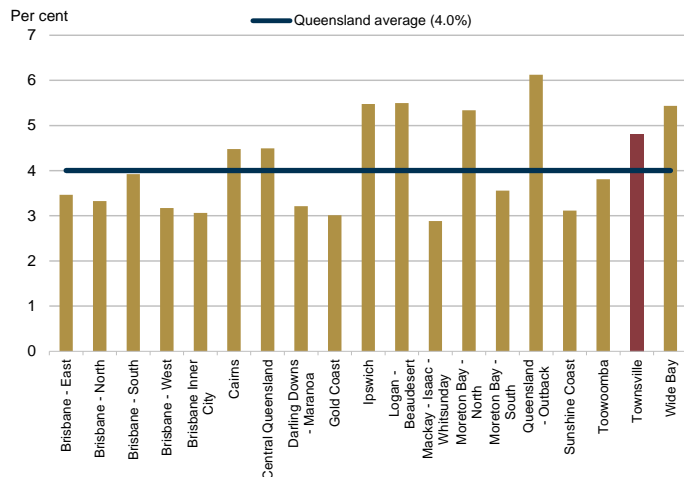


Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, July 2025

- The unemployment rate in Townsville SA4 in July 2025 was 4.8%, higher than the Queensland average of 4.0% (Figure 1). The unemployment rate for this area was the sixth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Townsville SA4 in July 2025 was 67.3%, an increase of 0.4 of a percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Unemployment rate, Townsville SA4 and Queensland
