Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates. The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- The number of employed persons in Toowoomba SA4 in December 2025 was 85,800 persons, an increase of 1,200 employed persons, or 1.4% over the year (Table 1).





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, December 2025

- The unemployment rate in Toowoomba SA4 in December 2025 was 3.8%, lower than the Queensland average of 4.1% (Figure 1). The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Toowoomba SA4 in December 2025 was 62.9%, unchanged over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Unemployment rate, Toowoomba SA4 and Queensland
