Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates. The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane - East SA4 in February 2026 was 141,500 persons, an increase of 2,100 employed persons, or 1.5% over the year (Table 1).





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, February 2026

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane - East SA4 in February 2026 was 3.7%, lower than the Queensland average of 4.2% (Figure 1). The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane - East SA4 in February 2026 was 68.7%, a decrease of 0.1 of a percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Participation rate refers to the number of persons in the labour force expressed as a percentage of persons aged 15 years and over.

Figure 1 Unemployment rate, Brisbane - East SA4 and Queensland
