## Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates. The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- The number of employed persons in Toowoomba SA4 in March 2026 was 86,000 persons, an increase of 1,100 employed persons, or 1.2% over the year (Table 1).
- The unemployment rate in Toowoomba SA4 in March 2026 was 3.9%, lower than the Queensland average of 4.1% (Figure 1). The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Toowoomba SA4 in March 2026 was 62.8%, unchanged over the year (Table 1).

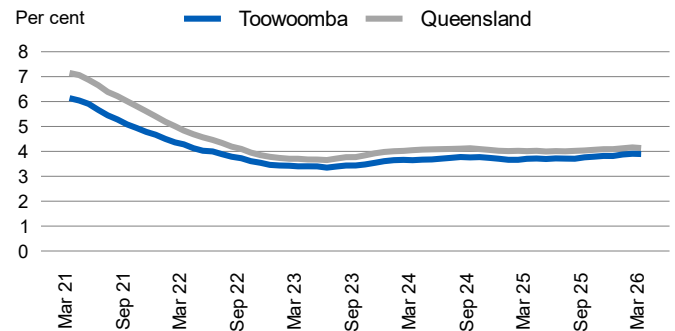

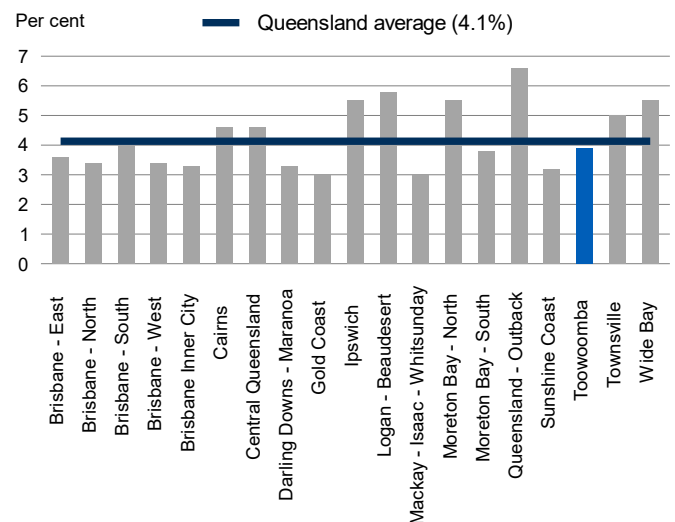
