## Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates. The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- The number of employed persons in Gold Coast SA4 in May 2026 was 397,800 persons, an increase of 6,000 employed persons, or 1.5% over the year (Table 1).
- The unemployment rate in Gold Coast SA4 in May 2026 was 3.1%, lower than the Queensland average of 4.1% (Figure 1). The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Gold Coast SA4 in May 2026 was 68.6%, a decrease of 0.3 of a percentage point over the year (Table 1).

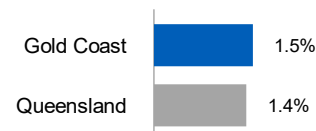

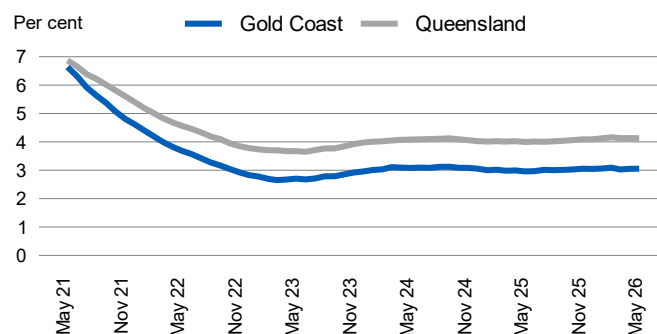

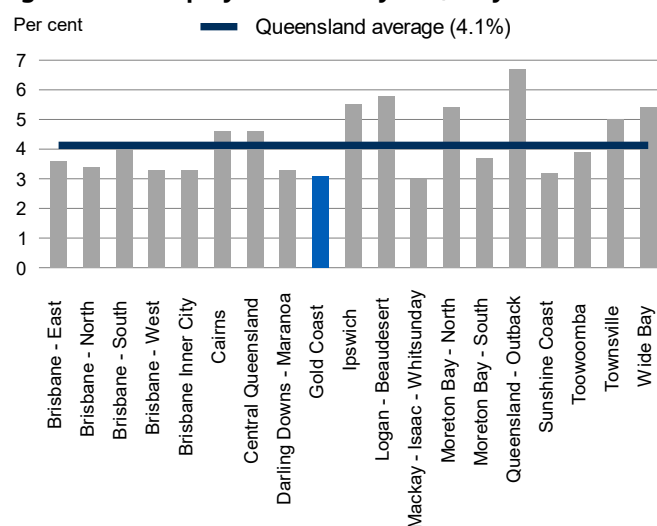
