## Main findings

Note: All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of modelled estimates due to seasonal variation and noise associated with regional labour force modelled estimates. The modelled regional labour force estimates enhance the direct survey estimates of regional labour market data using administrative data and statistical modelling.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in July 2026 was 209,100 persons, an increase of 4,600 employed persons, or 2.2% over the year (Table 1).
- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in July 2026 was 5.6%, higher than the Queensland average of 4.2% (Figure 1). The unemployment rate for this area was the third-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in July 2026 was 66.9%, a decrease of 0.1 of a percentage point over the year (Table 1).

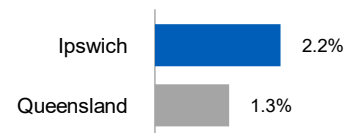

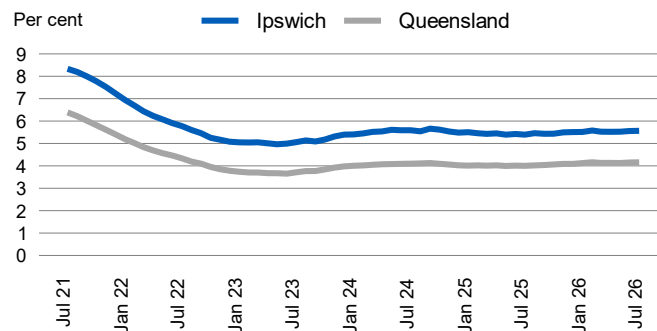

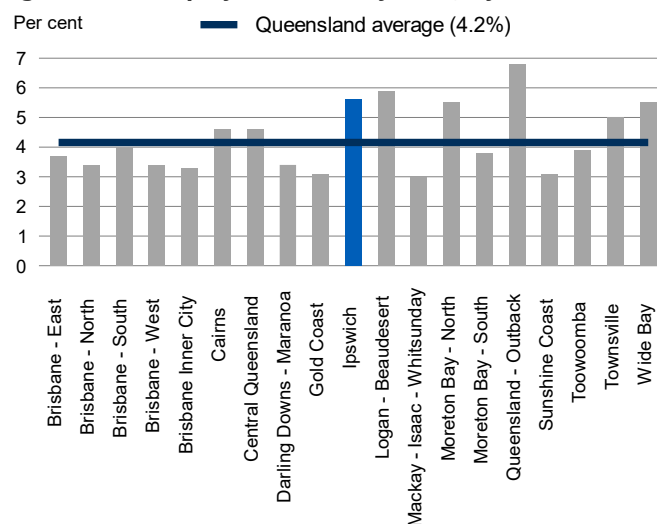
