
Main findings


Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.


All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 had the lowest youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during December 2024 with an unemployment rate of 5.4 per cent (Figure 1).
- Logan Beaudesert SA4 had the highest youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during December 2024 with an unemployment rate of 12.5 per cent (Figure 1).
- Moreton Bay North SA4 had the largest percentage point decrease in the youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to December 2024 with an unemployment rate decrease of 4.2 percentage points (Figure 2).
- Queensland Outback SA4 had the largest percentage point increase in the youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to December 2024 with an unemployment rate increase of 4.5 percentage points (Figure 2).
