Main findings

- Brisbane's headline consumer price index (CPI) increased 0.6% in December quarter 2024, resulting in a 1.8% increase over the year. In annual terms, Brisbane recorded the sixth-largest increase while Perth recorded the largest increase for all capital cities in Australia (see Table 1).
- Compared with the weighted average of eight capital cities for December quarter 2024, Brisbane recorded stronger contributions from the CPI groups of Housing, Clothing and footwear, Food and non-alcoholic beverages and Alcohol and tobacco. These were partly offset by detractions from the Transport, Furnishings, household equipment and services and Health groups (see Figure 1).
- For Brisbane, the *Housing* group made the largest contribution to inflation in December quarter 2024 (0.36 of a percentage point). Within the *Housing* group, *Electricity* increased 219.8% in the quarter due to the \$1,000 Queensland State Government rebate being partially used up by some households this quarter.
- For Brisbane, the *Transport* group recorded the largest detraction from inflation in December quarter 2024 (0.20 of a percentage point). Within the *Transport* group, *Urban transport fares* decreased 26.9% in the quarter.




Figure 2 CPI annual change, Australia

- Australia's CPI for market sector goods and services, which excludes more volatile items, increased 0.7% in December quarter 2024, with an annual inflation rate of 3.2% (see Figure 2).

Figure 1 Quarterly CPI contributions, by group, December quarter 2024
