Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from February 2020. All results are therefore presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover increased 0.9% in November 2021. Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 7.3% in November 2021.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover increased from \$6,644.4 million in October 2021 to \$6,703.6 million in November 2021.

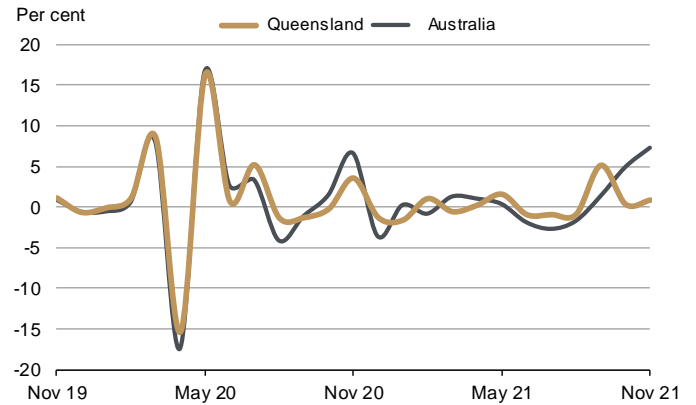


Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, November 2021

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 3.1% over the previous 12 months, from \$6,501.4 million in November 2020 (Figure 2).
- Queensland recorded the seventh-highest annual growth in retail turnover of all states and territories (3.1%). Victoria recorded the highest increase (8.4%).

Figure 1 Monthly change in retail turnover
