## Key data

## Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from February 2020. All results are therefore presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover increased 0.7% in June 2022. Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 0.2% in June 2022.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover increased from \$7,101.0 million in May 2022 to \$7,153.9 million in June 2022.

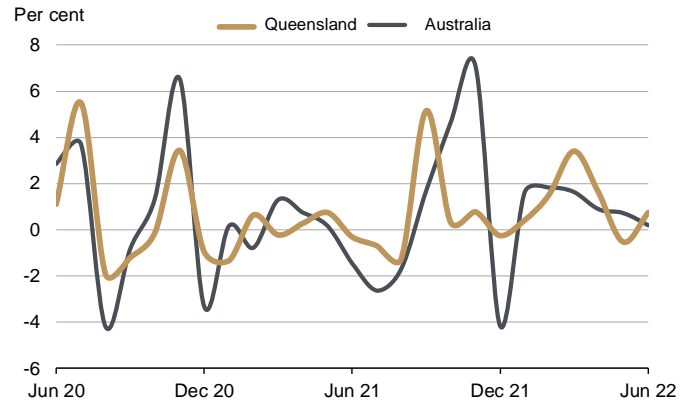


Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, June 2022

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 11.6% over the previous 12 months, from \$6,411.3 million in June 2021 (Figure 2).
- Queensland recorded the second-highest annual growth in retail turnover of all states and territories (11.6%). Victoria recorded the highest increase (16.3%).

Figure 1 Monthly change in retail turnover
