Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from February 2020. All results are therefore presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover increased 0.5% in October 2024. Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 0.6% in October 2024.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover increased from \$7,526.9 million in September 2024 to \$7,566.8 million in October 2024.
- The increase in Queensland's nominal retail turnover in October 2024 reflected higher spending in *Food retailing* and *Other retailing*.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 3.9% over the previous 12 months, from \$7,280.5 million in October 2023 (Figure 2).
- Queensland recorded the third-highest annual growth in retail turnover of all states and territories (3.9%). Western Australia recorded the highest increase (4.1%).
- Food retailing recorded the largest contribution to retail turnover growth in Queensland in the month (0.28 percentage point). Other retailing recorded the largest contribution to retail turnover growth in Australia (0.25 percentage point) in October 2024 (Figure 3).
